3. Decided to make efforts for complete automation of office and library in phased manner.
4. To make facility of Internet to all the students and staff, an Internet Centre is to be established.
5. Decided to request the senior professors of this University and other Universities to visit our PG Department to give guest lecturers on required topics.

6. Decided to make arrangements for Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC) to prepare students for competitive exams and to conduct Yoga classes and also to improve other communicative and soft skills.
7. To make necessary efforts by requesting the APSRTC officers to run more number of Bus services in this route which is more convenient to the day scholars
8. To improve the science labs with modern equipments
9. To conduct seminars by asking UGC and Management aid
10. To improve the number of Library books & Journals
11. To improve the infrastructure facilities, it is decided to construct of class rooms and examination hall by getting aid from UGC and management.

### **Out come at end of the Year**

1. Language Laboratory was established
2. Facility of ladies Hostel and waiting room were improved
3. Library automation is completed
4. Internet Centre was established with skilled person as in charge to the net centre
5. On request the Senior professors of the Acharya Nagarjuna University are coming and giving guest lecture to the P.G Department.
6. J.K.C was established and classes were taken by the experts on various fields.

7. On request the APSRTC, Repalle Depot and Bapatla Depot were arranged number of bus services in this route to facilitate the Day Scholars of our college.
8. Two UGC seminars were conducted by getting aid and permission of the UGC in our college.
9. UGC sanctioned Rs. 15,04,234/- for the construction of 4 class rooms and examination Hall and they were constructed.
